| <b>Literacy</b><br>Will be uploaded onto Tapestry at 9.30am | <b>What's in the box?</b><br>Join in on Tapestry or have pictures of different things in a box. Sound out the words together to find out what is in the box!   | <b>Tricky word bingo</b><br>Choose 8 words from the tricky words <b>I, to, the, no, go, into, he, she, me, we, be, you, was, they, all, are, her</b> to make a bingo board. Ask a grown up to call out the tricky word and cross it off if it is on your board. | <b>One Armed Robot letters</b><br>Practise forming the letters <b>r, n, m, p, b, h</b> correctly by going down the robot, back up and over his one arm. Spell some words with robot letters in; run, hum, bump etc | <b>Jumbled sentences</b><br>Listen to the text on Tapestry or use your school book. Copy a sentence, cut up the words, jumble them about and put it back together. Remember all sentences start with a capital letter, there are finger spaces between words and a sentence must end with a full stop or ! or ? | <b>Magnetic letters</b><br>Join in with helping to make words using magnetic letters on Tapestry or have a go at home with your own letters (you can always cut up squares of paper and write letters on them) to make words such as <b>sun, run, bun, fun, gun.</b> |
| <b>Maths</b><br>Will be uploaded onto Tapestry at 10.30am   | <b>One more (1-20)</b><br>Can you count different amounts of objects and then find out what one more would be?   | <b>One less (1-20)</b><br>Can you count different amounts of objects and then find out what one less would be?  | <b>Practical addition</b><br>Can you find the total amount of two groups of objects and draw your number story?  | <b>Practical subtraction</b><br>Can you take a small amount away from a larger amount and draw your number story?   | <b>Position</b><br>Using your favourite toy, can you listen to instructions involving the words <b>in, on, under, between, next to?</b>  |
| <b>Topic</b>  | Draw a picture of who lives in your house.   | Draw a family tree.   | Lay the table for dinner and count how many plates, knives, forks and cups are on the table.   | Play a family board game.   | Go on a number hunt around your home. What numbers can you see? (phone, TV remote etc)   |
